Key Scriptures:

Matthew 26:36-46

Proverbs 4:23

Summary

On Sunday, we spent some time with Jesus and His friends in Gethsemane. We tried to look at three specific challenges coming out of the passage. These challenges will form the basis of our questions for this week.

CHALLENGE 1: Are we asleep on the job of our faith or are we watching and praying, taking care not just of the external, but of our hearts and staying alert to what is coming against us?

CHALLENGE 2: Are we living life in our own strength or are we doing it with Him? Are we learning to be more dependent on His leadership and guidance in our lives?

CHALLENGE 3: Are we living confidently in the power of the gospel? Are we confident in the power of His grace and faithfulness to overtake and overcome our weaknesses and failures?

Questions:

1. How can you be keeping watch and praying, not just over the external things of life, but also over your heart? How does Jesus inspire us towards this in our passage?
2. What might a deeper dependency on God and His leadership look like in your life?
3. When it comes to our weaknesses and failures, how are we allowing the power of the gospel to change and transform our lives?
