
Confident in Relationships Part 2

Why would you be paid?


Well, I'd have to pay for travel and it would take a few hours out of my day. I would need to be compensated for that.


I can't believe you are trying to scam money out of me! All I am asking for is a quick favour because your handover is so bad ... and you are trying to take advantage.





- Slaves, obey your earthly masters (Eph 6:5)



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
Paul's "Flip":

- Masters, treat your slaves in the same way (Eph 6:9)


