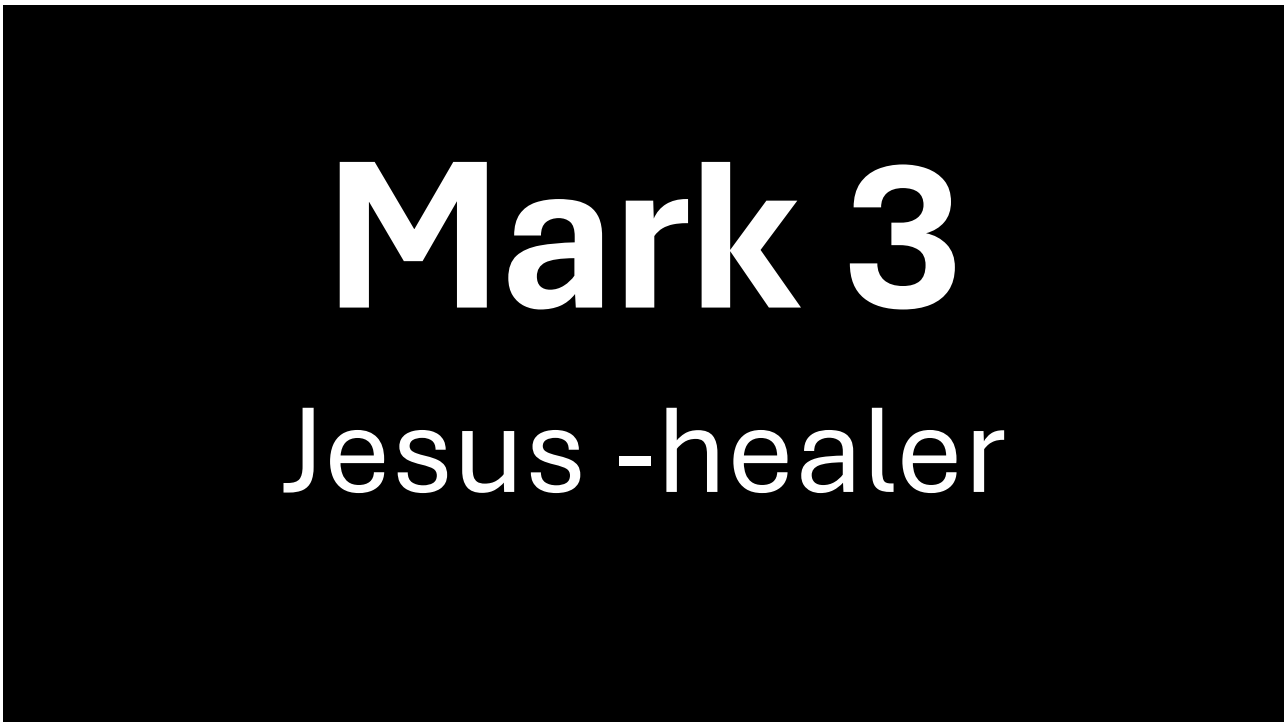

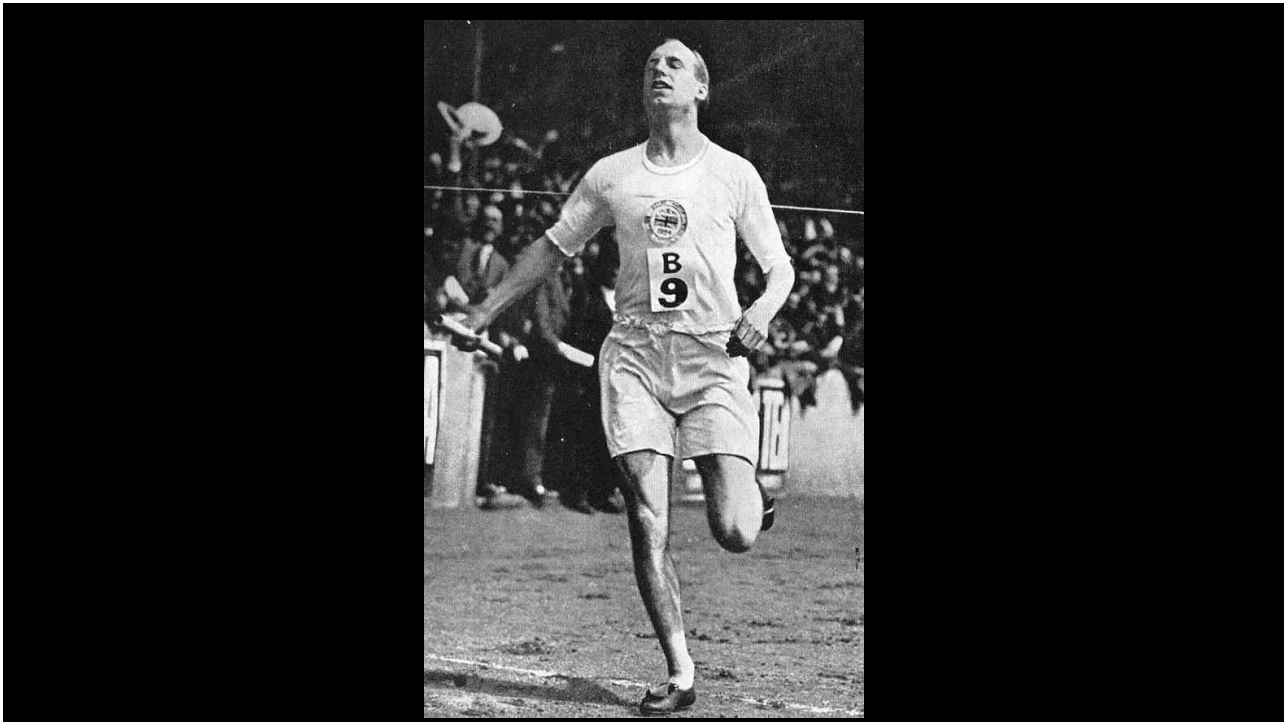
Mark 3

- (v31-35 Jesus' mother and brothers)

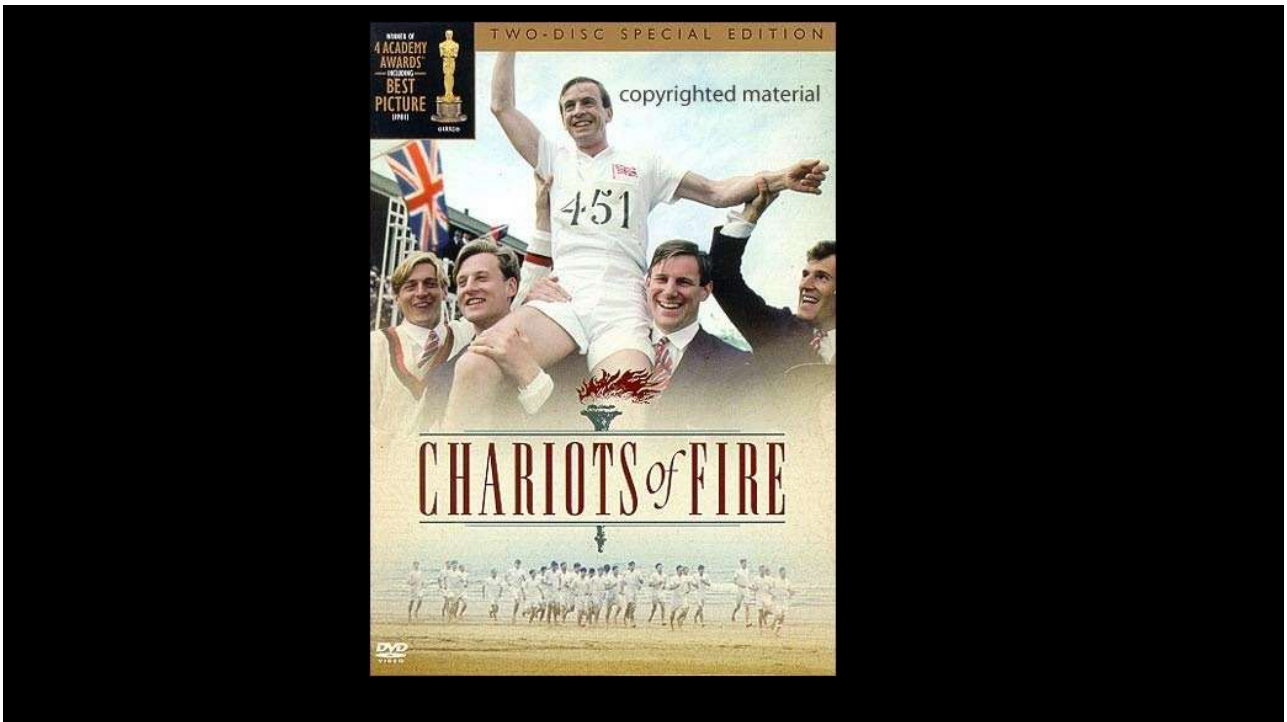

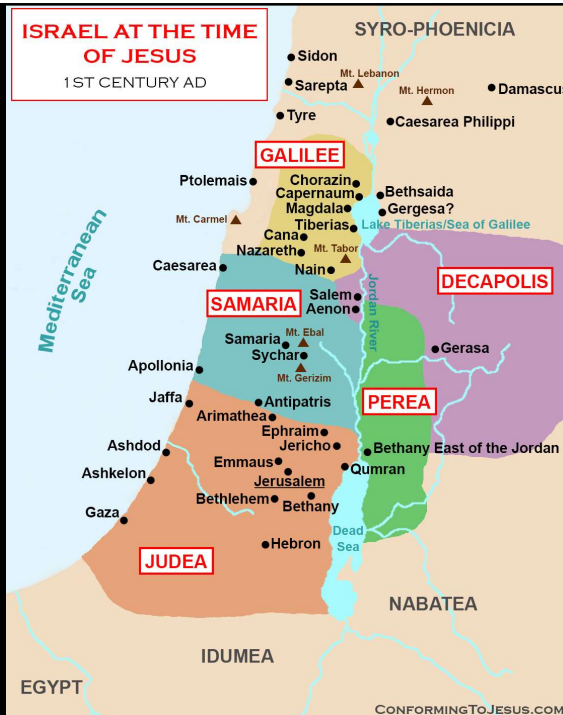

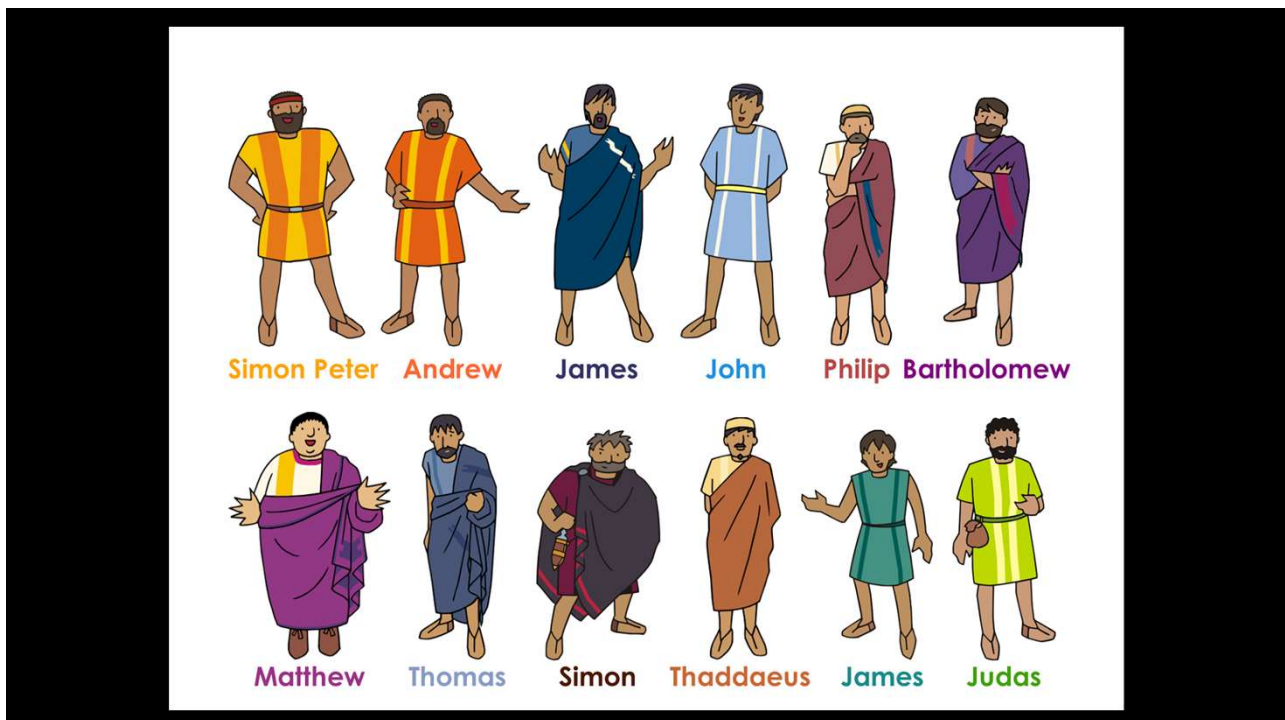
Jesus calls the twelve
