<u>Dealing with Disappointment</u>

Key Scripture: John 11:1-44

The bible helpfully breaks this story down into 3 sections which is how we looked at it on Sunday. The 3 words linking to the 3 sections were:

- 1. DELAY
- 2. DESPAIR
- 3. DECAY

QUESTIONS

Take a few minutes to read the whole story out loud, together as a group.

- **1.** As you read and heard the story as a whole, were there any things that reminded you about anything from Sundays message?
- 2. Focus on John 11:1-16. Section one was all about 'delay'. 'Sometimes disappointment can grab hold of us in our perception of the delay in God's activity'. Can you relate to this kind of disappointment?
- 3. Focus on John 11:17-37. Section two was all about 'despair'. 'Sometimes disappointment has the greatest opportunity to grab hold of us in the midst of our deepest despair'. What can we learn from Martha and Mary in the way that they handle their disappointment in this story?
- **4.** How can we make a move towards Jesus in our disappointments?
- **5.** How can we develop a consistent posture towards Jesus as Mary clearly has when we see her in scripture?
- **6.** Mary needed a little help to make her move towards Jesus. Are you carrying disappointments in your life that hinder your relationship with God and how could you ask for help in that?
