<u>'Oh Bother'</u> <u>'ITS . NOT . OVER'</u> 18th November 2018

Key Scripture: Mark 5

Heart of message: In the most desperate and hopeless situations, God can still work miracles and break through the impossible. As He does here in Mark 5. When we feel that 'its over' lets remember how utterly passionate and committed Jesus is to our healing and freedom. Its not over!

Questions:

Start by reading Mark 5 together

- 1. What initially struck you as you read this passage?
- 2. Take some time to talk about the situations of the three main characters in our passage. What is similar about them, what is different etc.
- 3. Chris used two main questions to frame the message. Spend a bit of time going over those questions as a group:
 - 1. How do we know these situations were hopeless?
 - 2. How did Jesus minister His freedom?
- 4. Are there any areas in your own life where you have lost hope? Where you feel like 'its over'?
- 5. When its says that the woman 'touched' Jesus' cloak in verse 27, that word in the original language means to 'grasp' or to 'hold on to'. How do we hold on to Jesus in our desperation and in our hopeless situations?
- 6. What do you think would help you to restore any lost faith in a God who can do the impossible?
