A1 Big Agenda	Establishing a culture of prayer
	CB led this item:
	Jesus sets a high bar around prayer and there are so many expressions of prayer. The meeting broke into small groups to discuss these expressions and what would we individually would commit to being a part of, bearing in mind our time commitments.
	We were all encouraged at the end of these discussions to each complete a "form" that gave ideas that we could get behind.
	The groups fed back some of the suggestions that had been discussed including:
	 Encouraging focused prayer for triplets / quads and for it to regular
	 Prayer ministry – offering in the side chapel as well as at the front – training to be offered
	• 24-hour prayer to be shaped that would involve and include more of the church family
	Being led in prayer within the gatherings
	 Visual prayer – to engage creatives, e.g. dance music for those who find words not necessarily helpful
	 Zoom prayer sessions on particular topics e.g. climate change
	 Empowering members of the church family to lead prayer sessions on areas that they are passionate about Prayer walks
	 Prayer warks The use of Jacob's well for prayer meetings
	 Use of social media where appropriate
	In summary people need to be offered different ways to engage in prayer whether that is
	corporately, in small groups or personal reflection.

A2 Big Agenda	Commit to specific involvement in the church family
	In small groups we shared what we had "signed up" to do to get involved and connect with
	the church family a few months ago.
	Some ideas that came out of that discussion was that at future meetings there would be small pieces of paper with ideas and we would all commit to doing one thing before the next PCC meeting – a further idea was to add a standing agenda item to feedback our experiences which would also give some accountability.
	ME mentioned that as a group many, if not all of us, are already oversubscribed on our church commitments and would it be a good idea to provide the church family with a list of suggestions and ideas on ways that they could also get involved i.e. most can invite someone to lunch or welcome someone new.
